

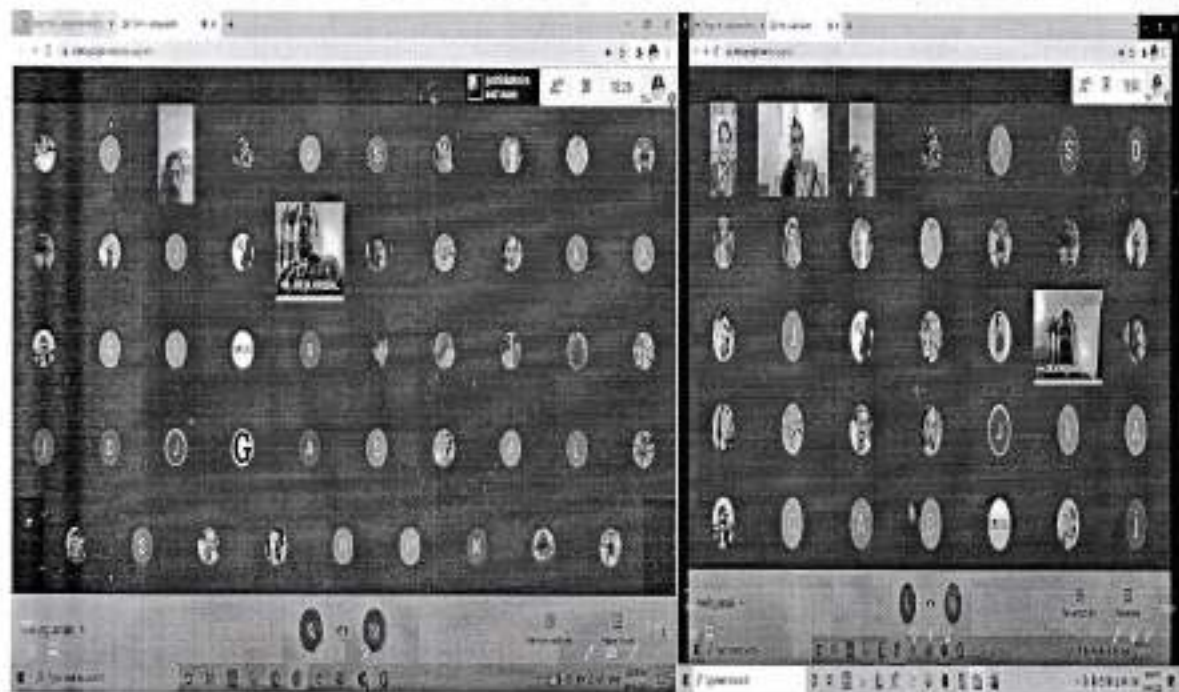
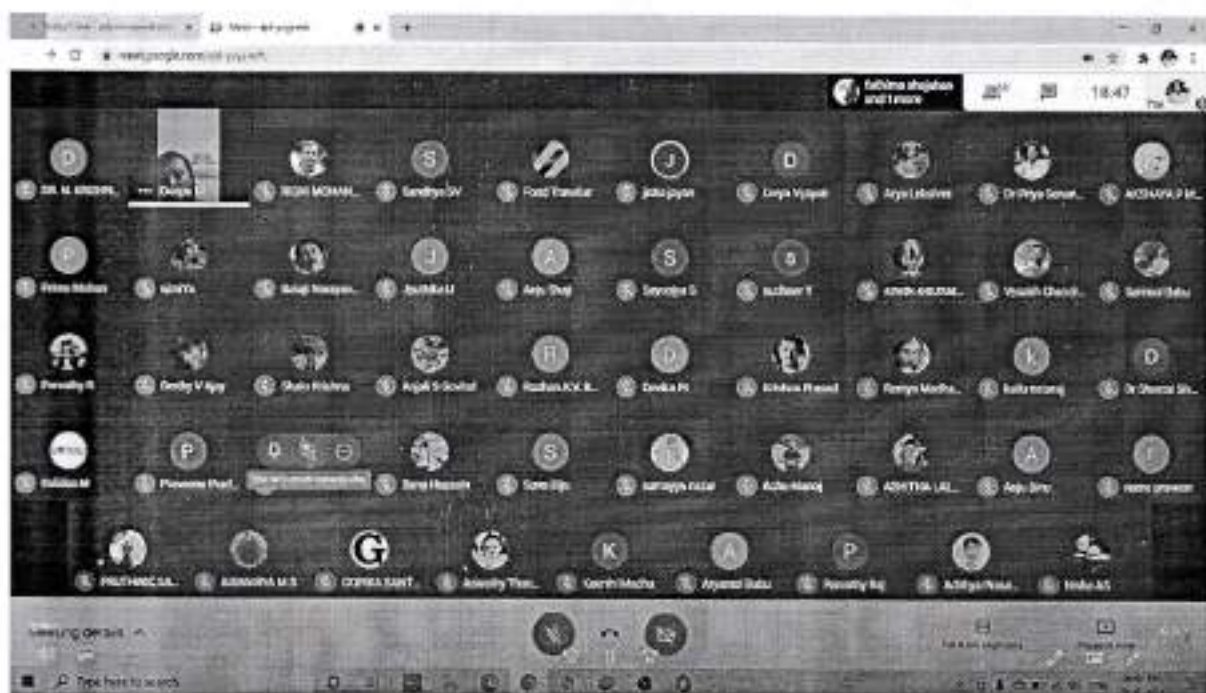

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TWO-DAY WORKSHOP ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

On 27th and 28th of June 2019, a "Two Day Workshop On Research Methodology" was conducted by the Commerce Club of the Department of Commerce for the final year B.Com students and it was coordinated by Dr P. S Ajith (Asso.Prof.) . The workshop was started at 10:00 am on 27th June 2019 by a prayer of Anju P Nair [3rd B.Com]. Mr Pradeepkumar P.S (Asso.Prof) ,the HOD of Commerce Department, welcome all who gathered at the workshop.The chief guest was Dr P N Harikumar [M.Com, MBA, M.Phil and Ph.D in Commerce and Management] Head of the Research and Post Graduate Department of Commerce, Catholicate College, Pathanamthitta who inaugurated the two day workshop He is a Research Supervisor in Commerce in MG University, Kottayam and produced more than 10 Ph Ds. In his inaugural lecture , he talked about the importance of education and how education is understood from different perspectives by scholars from different disciplines. He pointed that research is more than an understanding of set of skills, it is a way of thinking. Research simply refers to search for knowledge and he explained some real scientific facts and pointed out the important characteristics of social science research. It is nothing but exploring relationship and causality between two or more factors in a systematic manner.The Presidential address was done by Dr Biju Pushpan (Principal) and he shared his findings and opinion. Mr Praveen Kumar V.S , Syndicate Member, MG University [Asst.Prof, Department of Computer Application] and Dr B. S Kishor Kumar, IQAC Coordinator [Asso.Prof, Department of Physical Education] addressed their opinions and suggestions. .Then Bhanu Lekshmi Vinod [3rd B.Com] proposed vote of thanks for all after the inauguration.



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The two day workshop on research methodology was co-ordinated successfully by Dr.PS Ajith. The core objective of the workshop was to equip the students with set of skills and potentiality to undertake the research very effectively. This workshop was designed to offer the practical guidelines and direct the students through all the stages of research from identifying a research problem to the submission of a dissertation and report writing. The workshop consists of both theory and practical and it was conducted through different stages.

Stage I: How to start with a project?

In the first stage of the two day workshop he explained how to start with a project. Research derives from a question or a problem and attempts to find measures to solve that problem. So the primary goal of every research is to find solution for the problem raised by it. Research collects, analyses and interprets data in order to find out solution for the problem. The data includes reports, records, statements, opinions, events, happenings and observations. Data requires interpretations. The quality of interpretation depends on the logical thinking and analytical mind of the researcher.

Research Process:

- A) Problem Identification
- B) Literature Review
- C) Objective Formation
- D) Identifying Variables



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E) Questionnaire Preparation

Stage II: How to prepare a questionnaire practically?

The second stage was about the preparation of questionnaire. Here the practical section has started. The speaker explained it with an example (consumer satisfaction of motor car). This section involves exercise of identifying the dependent and independent variables in various studies along with discussions and after that statements should be prepared according to the variables. According to the variables the questions are prepared. The questions must be prepared module by module. After this the questionnaire will be completed. Then he explained how to write the analysis and interpretation and finally explained the importance of project report.

The second day was concluded with a vote of thanks by Devu R B (3rd B.Com). She extended her expression of gratitude to all partners who contributed for the realization of the workshop. This gave an adjournment to the inauguration of two days research methodology workshop and left the podium for the workshop on research methodology at 3:20 pm (28th June 2019) after distributing the participation certificate to the students.

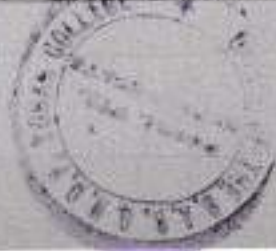

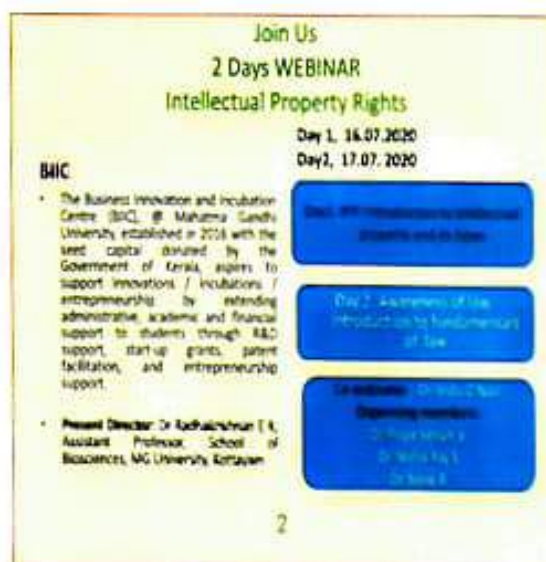
REPORT : WEBINAR ON INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

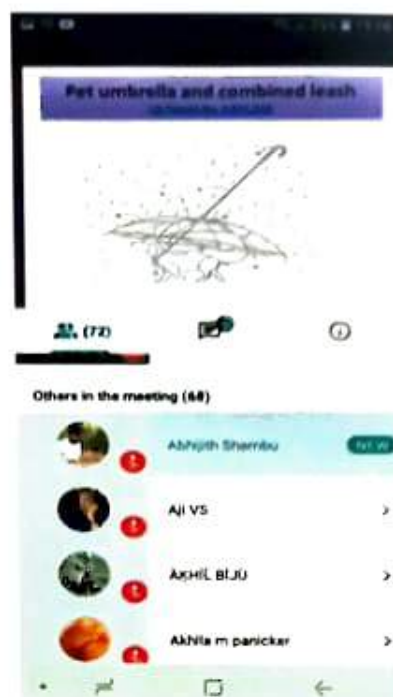

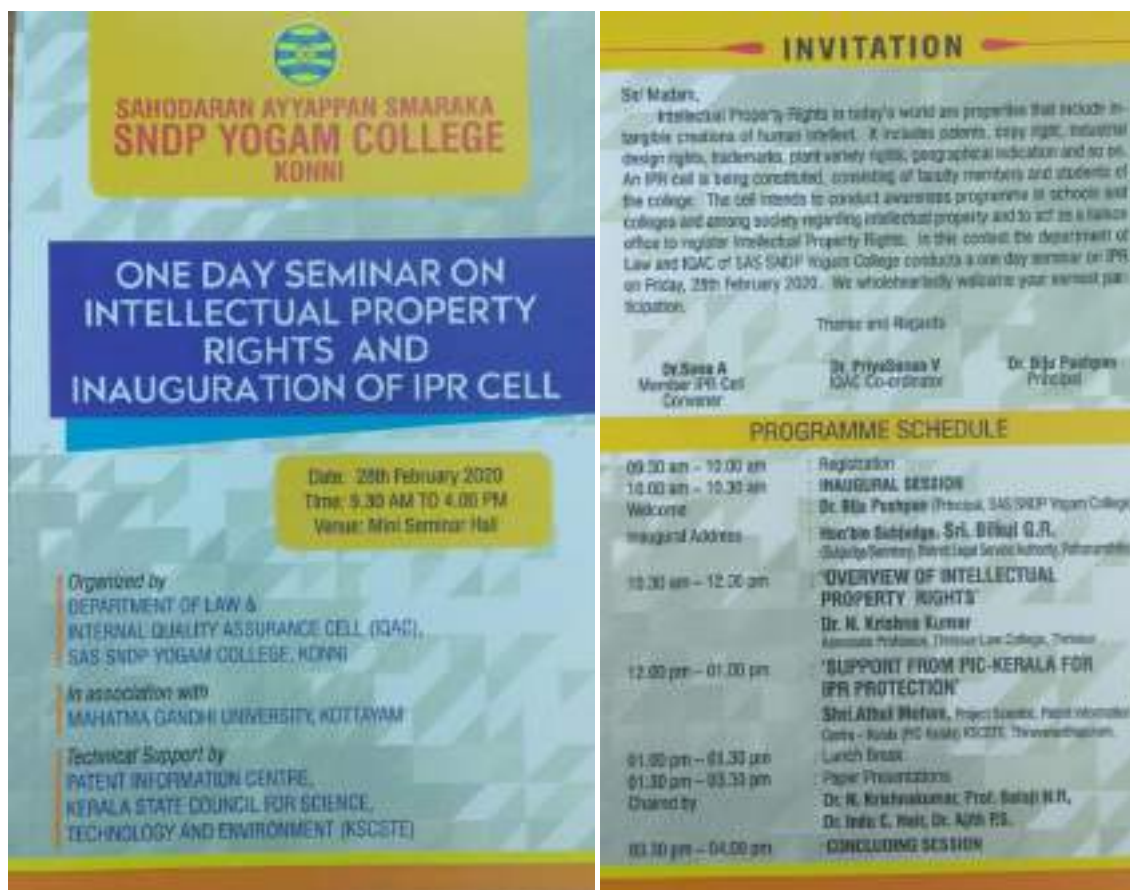
